44 schools reporting

**1. Type of Institution:**

Public: 33 Private: 11

**2. Years as chair:**

10.1±8.5 years (mean±SD; range 1-28 years)

**3. Do you get an administrative stipend for being chair?**

Yes: 37 No: 7 (84% yes) - Some chairs negotiate a salary with the Dean each year with no separation of base and admin stipend.

**4. If so, is it a percent of your base salary or a fixed amount?**

Percent: 3 Fixed: 34 (92% fixed)

**5. If a percent, what percent?**

13, 20 and 30% (just 3 chairs)

**6. If fixed, what is the dollar amount?**

\$32,175±28,132 (mean±SD; range 6K-100K)

**7. Have administrative supplements ever been increased or decreased since you became chair?**

Increased: 10 Decreased: 0 No change: 26 (72% no change)

**8. Who funds the administrative stipends?**

Deans office: 29 Department: 8 (78.4% Deans office)

**9. Are yearly raises based on your base salary or your base plus administrative stipend?**

Base only: 21 Base + Admin stipend: 13 (56.7% base only)-Two chairs commented they haven't had any raises.

**10. If you step down as chair does your base salary remain the same?**

Yes: 29 No: 9 (76.3% same salary)
